Violation of these rules, or of any rule implied by the general codes of conduct in area public and private schools, will result in immediate suspension from the workshop. A violator will be restricted to his or her dorm room and/or parents will be notified as soon as possible and instructed to come to the facility to escort the workshop participant home immediately at the parents' expense. No refunds will be given.
